With an introduction by novelist David Vann Jon Krakauer's *Into the Wild* examines the true story of Chris McCandless, a young man, who in 1992 walked deep into the Alaskan wilderness and whose SOS note and emaciated corpse were found four months later.

Internationally bestselling author and mountaineer Jon Krakauer explores the obsession which leads some people to discover the outer limits of self, leave civilization behind and seek enlightenment through solitude and contact with nature. In 2007, *Into the Wild* was adapted as a critically acclaimed film, directed by Sean Penn and Emile Hirsch and Kristen Stewart.

In a long and successful career on stage, screen, radio, and television, Academy Award-winning actress Anne Baxter was best known for her roles in the film classics *The Razor's Edge* (1946) and *All about Eve* (1950). This bio-bibliography describes her life and career in a biography and chronology, and details her achievements in the different production media, providing full credits, synopses, and review sources for the films and plays.
