Excerpt from The Mission of San Xavier Del Bac: An Historical Guide The building, which is of burned brick, fronts south and is 67 by 105 feet with two towers and a dome. It is of mission architecture, that is, the architecture of the Spanish Renaissance, modified by native influences.
