Shamash clearly loved the world in which she grew up but is altogether honest in her depiction of the

transformation of attitudes toward Baghdad's Jewish population. Shamash's world is finally shattered by the Farhud, the name given to the massacre of hundreds of Iraqi Jews over three days in 1941.
