

## Bordello

During a career spanning 20 years, the band Gogol Bordello has put the gypsy punk music genre on the map with their one-of-a-kind theatrical stage shows and continual touring. Eleven film appearances, seven full-length albums, and a successful Coca-Cola advertising campaign have propelled the group to an incontestable level of stardom. This case study explores how the multicultural Gogol Bordello has navigated the music industry and has been able to craft a niche for itself using grassroots marketing strategies. In addition, it considers and questions the risks and rewards of managing a band such as Gogol Bordello. Finally, while reading this case study, students will be asked to evaluate how developing a band is similar to or different from starting any other business venture.

This book captures the excitement and heartbreak of D. Donaldson as she grew up in Texas in the 1940s and 1950s, giving insight to some of the tragic realities for women during this time. Her story begins with a brief touch on her early life in Texas in the late 1930s and quickly delves into her abandonment at a convent in Dallas. Ms. Donaldson was left with aloof nuns for six years before she was rescued by her uncle. Unfortunately, her troubles did not end there, and she recounts her abusive first marriage before tackling the most traumatic event of her life, her kidnapping and subsequent enslavement in a Bordello in Galveston, Texas. She describes in brilliant detail the life of a whore in Galveston. She was eventually rescued from the bordello and made it back home to her family, where she had a difficult time adjusting to everyday life again. Ms. Donaldson then relates to the reader the details of her love affair with an Italian crime boss before concluding her story with brief touches on other parts of her life after Galveston.

The Charleston streets are dressed for the holidays in sophisticated Southern style: topiaries adorned with red ribbons, garland entwined with white lights, and poinsettias potted in gold planters. The high class bordello in a stately historic home is certainly no exception. When Private Investigator Liz Talbot's dear friend Olivia swears she saw a dead body in the parlor of this bordello, one Olivia accidentally co-owns, Liz promptly comes to her aid. With her wedding back home on Stella Maris less than a week away, Liz must juggle one elderly madam, two ex and future in-laws, three ghosts in the bordello, four giddy bridesmaids, five lovely courtesans, six suspicious patrons ... and a partridge in a pear tree as she tries to keep her bridesmaid out of jail and live to walk down the aisle.

Madam Fannie Porter runs the best bordello in Texas. Just ask the outlaws she harbored and entertained for the weekend-Butch Cassidy and his Wild Bunch. But when the gang rides off, Sadie, her best soiled dove, is left unhinged. While the Pinkerton Detective Agency remains

Neither is good news for Miss Fannie. First, she will never give up a client. Second, while pondering the upcoming temperance powwow, she relies on her business savvy. She forbids her girls from attending the meeting and hires a pianist, the talented, yet virtuous, Meta, to keep the customers coming. When a temperance woman is found murdered, Sadie becomes the key suspect. Now, Miss Fannie and Meta must discover the truth before the WCTU-or the killer-nails the red door, or another coffin, shut. The Last Bordello, is not only a who-dun-it. It is a story about powerful women who fought for their standing in life. Unable to obtain money in other ways, some women found prostitution to be their only means of survival. While the Women's Christian Temperance Union and Suffragettes strived to improve the lives of all women, the "ladies of the night" saw them as an opposing force. The Last Bordello depicts the struggle and determination of both sides.

My story involves two unlikely people, who fell in love, under most unusual circumstances. They both came from somewhat different childhood backgrounds. Both shared some of the same pain, knowing that they were different; caused by some painful wounds, both physical and psychological. Wounds which had been inflicted on them by others and yet, they somehow found in each other, compassion and an understanding, which developed into a life long love affair.
