This is true of everything from invitations you send out to art you create for display. Words have specific meanings, but the way that a word is viewed versus heard can affect how it's perceived. Calligraphy allows you to subtly enhance each letter, putting in different flourishes, curls, and lines. Small differences work their way in, which is part of what makes the finished effect so beautiful. Of all the art forms that I've studied and used over the years, calligraphy is one of the most under appreciated. As I began looking at different fonts to reproduce, I realized that was I was looking for was calligraphy. It didn't take me long to realize that calligraphy allowed me to personalize things far more than using a computer font or a sticker ever could.
