Lessons supposedly gleaned from these campaigns heavily influenced British military aviation, underpinning RAF doctrine up to and into the Second World War. Fundamental discrepancies exist, however, between the official verdict and the first-hand evidence of bombing results gathered by intelligence teams of the RAF and the US Air Service. Results of the British bombing efforts were demonstrably more modest, and costs in casualties and wastage far steeper, than previously acknowledged. A preoccupation with "moral effect" came to dominate the British view of their aerial offensives. Maj Gen Hugh M. Trenchard played a pivotal role in bringing this misperception to the forefront of public consciousness. After the Armistice, the potential of strategic bombing was officially extolled to justify the RAF as an independent service. The Air Ministry's final report must be evaluated as a partisan manifestation of this crusade and not as a definitive final assessment, as it has been mistakenly accepted previously. This study develops and substantiates a comprehensive evaluation of British long-range bombing in the First World War. Its findings run directly counter to the generally held opinion. Natural limitations, technical shortfalls, and aircrews lacking proficiency acted in concert with German defenses to produce far less results than those claimed.

The Anarchist's Guide to Grammar: "Banish the "rules" of grammar in the U.S.!" is the revolution called for by author Val Dumond. "Scary? Of course, but drastic measures must be taken. We make several assumptions: 1) that we have a language called "Proper English"; 2) that a set of "rules" lies in some mysterious place, written by some mysterious authority; 3) that one must follow those "rules" to speak and write correctly. Not so! The time has arrived to banish what we call "rules" and expose the assumptions." Dumond asks: What would happen if we all spoke the language of our heritage? We would quickly learn the sound of the Tower of Babel - since US-language has come about by combining languages from (at least) 150 countries around the world. As immigrants enter the country, they bring with them new ideas, cultures, foods, music, and language. As they become settled, they combine their culture with US-ers, thus enriching all of us in the United States, including our language. In an amusing Introduction, Val explains how we have assumed there exists an incontrovertible set of grammar "rules" to be followed in order to speak proper, correct, good English. "We're not in England anymore!" she points out. Oh yes, we started out with British "rules," but as we declared our independence, language changed, and continues to change. Do you really understand ordinary British English? Numerous pundits over time have drawn up what they consider the "rules" of grammar and forced them on their students. Yet, when those students run up against someone who studied a different set of "rules," confusion and doubt rear their heads. Must we in the U.S. speak "proper English" or do we have a language all our own? After clarifying the conundrum of US-language, Dumond offers guidelines to aid writers in determining what constitutes understandable language. Those guidelines don't depend on memorizing all the crazy names for the parts of language, but rather the guidelines focus on how those parts function. Nouns and pronouns become Things; adjectives and adverbs become Modifiers; punctuation becomes Rules of the Road - all presented in easily understood language, with examples to boot. Included in the guidelines are ways to decide which nouns to capitalize how to discern the difference between plural and possessive nouns how pronouns perform ways to vary word modifiers how to add modifying phrases and clauses use of the little words that serve as the glue to connect words into sentences how to use the dots, dashes, and curly cues we call punctuation. But she doesn't stop there. Writers will especially enjoy the freedom offered to create new words and put together sentences and paragraphs. She offers suggestions to use numbers and inclusive language, as well as offering four ways to improve spelling. The solution to the confusion of US-language seems so simple. Look at the "rules" that come close to your interpretation, then modify them to make them work for you. Set up Your Style Manual, rather than depend on style manuals put together according to some other group's interpretations. And she shows you how. MU highlights the limitations of M&M fiscal and monetary policies, active investment management and the myriad government programs designed to improve the economic well-being of people. MU reveals the tenuous nature of the models historically taught in M&M, that our current M&M canon is defunct and that we instituting ad hoc M&M policy with the hope that our future economic output will suffice for all the commitments we have made. Indeed, M&M parables and models are insightful about national economies, especially their historical development. M&M does not, however, constitute a body of scientific ideas to perform successful proactive government M&M policy and to engender greater economic output by the macroeconomic manipulations of interest rates and aggregate demand. Economic policy advocates, whether conservative or liberal, break on prejudices. The prevailing intellectual economic prejudice in America today, perhaps more than in any other society, is Keynesianism. American society perceives spending as the source of greater economic output. The other major player in our economic lives - the investment community or "Wall Street" - has been inordinately successful in the period from about 1980 until the present, i.e. over the lifetimes of the people who currently run America. Portfolios of assets, including stocks, bonds and real estate, have yielded high rates of return. This era was a unique period of asset price increases motivated by a fortuitous combination of underlying economic and social conditions. Through Wall Street and our central bank we have valued every asset to its maximum. We bet our economic future on the continuation of rising asset valuations. Future returns will be much lower, however, and we will face constant government budget shortfalls and related insolvencies like those of many pensions. In America we admire our central bank for managing the macroeconomy and we admire Wall Street for providing high rates of return but both are illusions. Our M&M story is largely a generational story about a generation that borrowed against the future of its children. Maximize Utility reveals the rightness of microeconomics. People are competent to manage their lives. To the extent they cannot, it is largely the result of a plethora of government interventions into education, family formation, healthcare, retirement, housing and labor markets. Our government patronizes our people extremely. Microeconomic parables are singular. Substitution, choice, preferences, technology, profit, marginal product, optimality, etc. are great ideas to think about our economic lives and how to run a household and live a fulfilling life. People need no nudges or supervisions of their choices. MU is three thrusts. It is a review of current economic conditions, a short text on M&M concepts and a section on methods in social and business science.
