Each devotion begins with a Scripture passage or a hymn text passage and closes with a brief prayer. By exploring the biblical basis for preaching, this book shows how fundamental theological issues

pertain to the proclamation of the Word. Donald English gives preachers and students of homiletics a theological basis for preaching, practical insights regarding the movement from text to sermon, and practical guidance in preparing for Sunday worship. Digging deeper into ministry means drawing closer to God and living His love for people. Regardless of whether we work full time in ministry or as tent-makers, Christian music

ministers must stay spiritually strong while working long hours both on and off the road. The Christian Musicians Devotional will help us develop a deeper love for God and for people.
