Bringing together scholars and practitioners from North America, Europe, Russia, and Australia, this pioneering volume provides a global survey of how museums address religion and charts a course for future research and interpretation. Contributors from a variety of disciplines and institutions explore the work of museums from many perspectives, including cultural studies, religious studies, and visual and material culture. Most museums throughout the world – whether art, archaeology, anthropology or history museums – include religious objects, and an increasing number are beginning to address religion as a major category of human identity. With rising museum attendance and the increasingly complex role of religion in social and geopolitical realities, this work of stewardship and interpretation is urgent and important. Religion in Museums is divided into six sections: museum buildings, reception, objects, collecting and research, interpretation of objects and exhibitions, and the representation of religion in different types of museums. Topics covered include repatriation, conservation, architectural design, exhibition, heritage, missionary collections, curation, collections and display, and the visitor's experience. Case studies provide comprehensive coverage and range from museums devoted specifically to the diversity of religious traditions, such as the State Museum of the History of Religion in St Petersburg, to exhibitions centered on religion at secular museums, such as Hajj: Journey to the Heart of Islam, at the British Museum.

La Dirección General de los Registros y del Notariado fue suprimida por Real Decreto 139/2020, de 28 de enero, por el que se establece la estructura orgánica básica de los departamentos ministeriales (artículo 2.2), siendo el órgano directivo que asume sus funciones la Dirección General de Seguridad Jurídica y Fe Pública. El Anuario del año 2018, que ahora se publica, mantiene la modificada estructura del año 2009, que conserva una división más racional para facilitar el uso y la consulta de sus contenidos y al mismo tiempo aprovechar las ventajas que nos ofrece la tecnología. La obra se presenta en tres grandes apartados. El apartado primero recoge las resoluciones relacionadas con la Subdirección General del Notariado y de los Registros. En este apartado las resoluciones publicadas en el «BOE» se incluyen reproduciéndolas tal cual las edita el citado «Boletín», haciendo referencia a la fecha, la página y al marginal de la disposición para su rápida localización en la Base de Datos del BOE, lo que conlleva el acceso al análisis jurídico y a su actualización diaria (con enlaces directos). En las resoluciones que se transcriben íntegramente se han omitido todas las referencias a datos personales, en armonía con la legislación sobre protección de datos de carácter personal. Este apartado primero incluye los Recursos (Resoluciones de los Registradores de la Propiedad, de los Registros Mercantiles, Registros de los Bienes Muebles y Corrección de errores de la D. Gral. de los Registros y del Notariado), el Nombramiento de auditores de cuentas y expertos independientes y las Resoluciones del Sistema Notarial, junto con las instrucciones, consultas y resoluciones del Sistema Registral. El apartado segundo está integrado por las resoluciones y consultas emitidas por la Dirección General de los Registros y del Notariado en relación con las materias de Nacionalidad y Estado Civil. Las modificaciones que se implantaron en este apartado están orientadas a facilitar su consulta, por lo que las resoluciones aparecen agrupadas por materias, según el índice temático referenciado, lo que facilita su localización sin necesidad de conocer la fecha concreta de la disposición, además, se incluye una completa relación cronológica. Para reducir el tamaño de la publicación, no se publican a texto completo todas las resoluciones dictadas, sino que dentro de cada apartado se han seleccionado aquellas que se consideran de mayor interés. Las resoluciones que son sustancialmente iguales solo se citan en una relación cronológica, indicando la fecha, orden y asunto sobre el que versan. El apartado tercero aglutina información relacionada con ambas Subdirecciones y está integrado por la Organización de la Dirección y Cuerpos dependientes de la misma y Estadísticas. ISSN: 2660-6453

This book is written in an easily accessible style and features a host of real-world examples to illustrate methodological points.

Education hubs are the newest development in the international higher education landscape. Countries, zones and cities are trying to position themselves as reputed centres for higher education and research. But given higher education's current preoccupation with competitiveness, branding, and economic benefits are education hubs merely a fad, a branding exercise, or are they an important innovation worthy of serious investment and attention? This book tries to answer the question through a systematic and

comparative analysis of the rationales, actors, policies, plans and accomplishments for six serious country level education hubs - United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Singapore and Botswana . The in-depth case studies shows that "one size does not fit all". A variety of factors drive countries to prepare and position themselves as an education hub. They include income generation, soft power, modernization of domestic tertiary education sector, economic competitiveness, need for trained work force, and most importantly a desire to move towards a knowledge or service based economy. In response to these different motivations, three different types of education hubs are being developed: the student hub, talent hub, and knowledge/innovation hub. Scholars, policy makers, professionals, students and senior decision makers from education, economics, geography, public policy, trade, migration will find that this book challenges some assumptions about crossborder education and provides new insights and information.

Written by formidable intellectual talents, committed to the study of fundamental rights, it rigorously analyses the most recent judgments of both the ECJ and the ECHR.

The Spanish nation has been contested almost since its conception in the early nineteenth century, and the Spanish state has therefore been involved in perpetual conflicts between various nationalisms, particularly between different versions of Spanish nationalism as well as between Spanish majority nationalism and various minority nationalisms. At different times in history, the conflicts have revived and turned into organizing principles of the political communities in Spain, as communities in conflict or contention but, nevertheless, as communities providing the Spaniards with different senses of belonging. In recent times, both lines of contention have been activated again, and in this volume, we focus particularly on the conflict between majority and minority nationalism, which has been revived from approximately 2010 around the Catalan separatist conflict, but other sub-state identities are potentially conflictual as well. Both the state-wide - Spanish - as well as the sub-state actors try to develop feelings of territorial attachments to the Spanish political community or to the respective sub-state political communities, and both use emotions and feelings to secure support and to assert or claim sovereignty for the political community in question. The contributions in this volume shed light on various issues related to these questions.
