Ki te Whaiao: An Introduction to M?ori Culture and Society, is intended for students of M?ori studies at tertiary institutions. It is also aimed at several other audiences: those M?ori who want to know more about their own world, P?keh? living in this country, and people from overseas who want to learn about the history of the Indigenous people of Aotearoa/New Zealand. The book describes traditional and contemporary M?ori society and its interaction with P?keh? society since first contact. It gives expression to the voices and words of M?ori scholars and those informed by their world-view. Emphasis has been placed on the clarification of M?ori cultural concepts throughout, in order to give readers a deeper understanding of the M?ori world and to excite their interest in the key themes developed throughout the text. The book has been arranged in two parts Part one is called Te Ao M?ori (The M?ori World) and examines a series of topics encompassing tribal histories about the creation, important cultural concepts, the migration journeys to Aotearoa, the origins of the M?ori language, cultural traditions and practices, leadership and M?ori performing and fine arts. Part two, Ng? Ao e Rua (The Two Worlds) examines early contact between M?ori and P?keh?, the Treaty and related issues, religion, sovereignty, education and literature, and ends with a chapter on the Pacific peoples in Aotearoa/New Zealand.
