Pourtant une fois les lunettes chaussées, les parties intéressantes surgissent de la page non pas en une succession de couches plates, comme dans les photos en 3 dimensions classiques, mais pour dessiner des contours pleins et ronds. Il ne fait aucun doute que ce livre est une
