However the problem with this is not only that it sometimes gets it wrong, but also that the way the eye might see a scene is many - if not most - times not the most beautiful/interesting way to capture that scene. For example if you were taking a picture of the sun at sunset your camera might automatically want to expose the image rather darkly, attempting to make both sun and landscape are properly exposed. Your camera does not realize that a much more interesting picture could be created if you exposed the image so that the landscape became the star of your photograph, exposing it so that it being the breathtaking landscape is well lit, rich and interesting. Or, you could use your camera's automatic setting and end up with the landscape being a too dark, uninteresting blob of dirt. Another reason to use your DSLR's manual setting is that of style.
