Vernon Anthony Walters was born in New York on January 3, 1917, during World War I. In that same year the Russian Revolution occurred, paving the way for the

implementation of the ideology of Communism, which Walters opposed throughout his entire professional career. In 1941, a few months before the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, Walters entered the Army and saw action in World War II. During his career, he also participated in the Korean and Vietnam Wars and witnessed conflicts in Greece, Paraguay, Chad, and Colombia. 2 He was the Ambassador to Germany in 1989 when the Berlin Wall fell; and in 1991 when he left public service, the dissolution of the Soviet Union was complete. When Walters died in February 2002, the world was only beginning to recover from the shock caused by the terrorist attacks of September 11 and to put the 20th century Cold War behind it.
