The obvious use for such a guide would be to obtain the part number for a relay that might power windshield wipers or turn signals. Ford suggests you read the guide from front to back. This may sound like a geeky thing to do, but having read this guide, I can assure you the small expenditure of time is well worth the knowledge you will gain over such a large investment. I was, for example, surprised to find out that the Ford F53 V10 will run in a "Fail Safe" mode when overheated. Half the cylinders will not fire but rather circulate air over the remaining cylinders to keep them cool!
