The IEEE Tutorial and Research Workshop on Perception and Interactive Technologies for Multimodal Dialogue Systems (PIT 2008) is the continuation of a successful series of workshops that started with an ISCA Tutorial and Research Workshop on Multimodal Dialogue Systems in 1999. This workshop was followed by a second one focusing on mobile dialogue systems (IDS 2002), a third one exploring the role of affect in dialogue (ADS 2004), and a fourth one focusing on perceptive interfaces (PIT 2006). accepted 37 papers come from industrial organizations or were written in collaboration with them.
