We all know about King David and King Solomon, but what about the kings Omri and Uzziah? Of the more than fifty monarchs who sat on the throne of the Jews for over 1000 years, most of us can recall only a few. What we do remember about them has been colored by legend and embellishment. In *Kings of the Jews*, Norman Gelb tells us the real stories of them all. Carnage, murder, starvation, eviction, and emigration follow in this exciting and stirring tale of nineteenth-century Ireland.

*Linguistics and the Teacher* is a collection of essays by linguists on different aspects of the relationship between linguistics and education. All the contributors are united in their belief that linguistics should be a central element in the education of teachers, and argue for principled and systematic analysis in the study of the role of language in learning.
