(2a) consists of a leaf from The New York Herald Tribune, Sunday March 15, 1925 which includes a "Shakespearean enigma" and (2b) is a separate leaf with the solution, a quotation from Julius Caesar, act 2, scene 2 ("Cowards die many times before their deaths; The valiant never taste of death but once").
