Based on author Herbie J Pilato's exclusive interviews with Elizabeth Montgomery prior to her death in 1995, *Twitch Upon a Star* includes insider material and commentary from several individuals associated with her remarkable life and career before, during, and after *Bewitched*, including her classic feature films *The Court Martial of Billy Mitchell* (1955), *Who's Been Sleeping In My Bed?* (1963), and *Johnny Cool* (1963). Two of Montgomery's many popular TV movies, *A Case of Rape* (which remains one of the highest-rated TV-movies of all time) and *The Legend of Lizzie Borden* (which will soon be remade as a feature film), were groundbreaking and remain classics. Joni Mitchell may be the most influential female recording artist and composer of the late twentieth century.
