Het creëren van een ebook in het ePub formaat, de standaard voor ebooks in Nederland, is niet zo eenvoudig als het lijkt; even een manuscript omzetten is er helaas niet bij. Wiebe de Jager beschrijft in deze praktijkgids hoe je een ebook maakt met het open source programma Sigil en hoe je het ebook vervolgens op de markt brengt. Deze gids is interessant voor zowel auteurs die hun ebook in eigen beheer willen uitgeven als uitgevers die aan de slag willen met digitale boeken. Behandeld wordt onder andere het importeren van een manuscript, het indelen in hoofdstukken, het toevoegen van structuur en opmaak, het invoegen van afbeeldingen en een omslag, het bewerken van metadata en het genereren en valideren van een ePub bestand dat gelezen kan worden op uiteenlopende apparaten, zoals ereaders, pcs, smartphones en tablets. Tot slot wordt ingegaan op de mogelijkheden om ebooks te promoten, distribueren, beveiligen en verkopen. Wiebe de Jager is directeur van uitgeverij Eburon en medeoprichter van eReaders.nl. Hij schrijft veel over ebooks op zijn weblog en in vakbladen. Hij is daarnaast een veel gevraagd spreker op het gebied van digitaal uitgeven en de toekomst van het boek.
