Neste livro, ela nos ajudará a abrimos nossas mentes para entendermos que Deus não nos quer doentes, e que temos a opção de continuarmos na ignorância ou de lutarmos, com todas as armas disponíveis, para livrar-nos da depressão. ""antes do Freeport, houve a Ota"... Quando o primeiro sem-abrigo aparece morto com dezoito facadas junto à Basílica da Estrela, ninguém mostra grande interesse. O serial killer começa, porém, a deixar pistas - e estas apontam para um culto satânico, mas também para a maçonaria. Com o medo a instalar-se em Lisboa, onde o assassino vai multiplicando os seus actos de violência, e enquanto Joel Franco começa a descobrir as origens desta vaga de crimes, o presidente da Câmara de Lisboa e um seu discreto aliado na própria PJ percebem quem é o autor das mortes: o homem que quiseram transformar em bode expiatório quando começou a correr mal o comércio ilícito de terrenos na zona do projectado aeroporto da Ota. No qual pontificara o presidente da Câmara quando ainda era ministro do Ambiente... E em breve vão estar frente a frente dois homens que, à sua maneira, procuram justiça: o assassino propriamente dito e Joel Franco, que tenta vingar a morte de um amigo de infância em cada homicida que persegue. É bem provável que ambos desafiem a antiquíssima norma que regula a sociedade humana: "Não matarás.""

D. W. Winnicott (1896-1971) was one of the giants of child psychiatry and analysis. Whether writing or talking, he always argued eloquently for an increased sensitivity to children, their development and their needs. His books such as *Playing and Reality* and *The Family and Individual Development*, are now considered classics in the field of child development. *Deprivation and Delinquency* is an invaluable compilation of his papers, talks, letters and lectures between 1930 and 1970, centred on the theme of the relationship between antisocial behaviour, or more chronically delinquency, and childhood experiences of deprivation. It does this by describing the interpersonal and group dynamics of decision-making at key stages in the processing of accused persons from the time an alleged offence is committed to the moment sentence is passed. The book bears directly on many current debates concerning the ability of the criminal justice system to deliver reliable verdicts. It recognizes the interdependence of decision makers in the system and addresses questions at an appropriately social-psychological level. The book examines systematically and critically the dynamics of criminal decision-making, the response of victims, the assumptions, attitudes and behavior of police officers, the conduct of court proceedings, the performance of witnesses, the strengths and weaknesses of juries, and the sentencing of magistrates and judges. Discussions of law and morality, the attribution of blame in court and in everyday life, and the achievement of justice in interpersonal and organizational contexts, provide a definitive account of the social psychology of law in the context of criminal justice. Problems with our adversarial system of justice have led to the establishment of a Royal Commission on Criminal Justice. It is commonplace to seek a scapegoat in the behavior of one or other protagonist in the system - especially the police. It will become clear to readers of this book that breakdowns of the system are a product of persuasive interpersonal and intergroup processes of organization, reaching well beyond the behavior of any one agent.
