Royal College of Surgeons in 1848 for an essay entitled *The Origin, Connexions and Distribution of nerves to the human eye and its appendages*, illustrated by comparative dissections of the eye in other vertebrate animals. In 1852, at the early age of 25, he was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society, and in the following year he obtained the Astley Cooper prize of three hundred guineas for a dissertation "On the structure and Use of Spleen."
