

Ulysses Moore 3 La Casa Degli Specchi

Fantagraphics collects the graphic novel Perramus ? winner of an Amnesty International prize ? in English for the first time. During his absurdist travels, he teams up with the gruff Cannelloni; a foreign aviator dubbed "The Enemy" by despot Mr. Whitesnow; and the blind author "Borges" (based on the real-life literary figure), who comes to be a guide. Perramus is a cartooning tour de force, with a revolutionary message that remains vital to this day.
